Detailed Monthly information for the month of July, 2023

Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

1. Rajkot International Airport, Gujarat was inaugurated by Hon'ble PM on 27.07.2023.
2. Fourth Runway and Eastern Cross Taxiway (ECT) at IGI Airport, Delhi was inaugurated on 14.07.2023 by Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation.
3. New Intergrated Terminal at Veer Sawarkar International Airport, Port Blair was inaugurated by Hon'ble PM on 21.07.2023.
4. AAICLAS has commissioned Air Cargo movement through Airline Self-Handling by M/s Indigo for Outbound Air Cargo Operations at Goa airport on 12.07.2023.
5. AAICLAS has received Regulated Agent (RA) for both Domestic and International air cargo operations for Pune Airport on 13.07.2023.
6. Six hundred and ninety nine drones were registered and Unique Identification Number (UIN) were issued.
7. Five hundred and forty four Remote Pilot certificates were issued.
8. Five new Remote Pilot Training Organisations (RPTO) commenced.
9. One new Flying Training Organisation (FTO), namely, EKVI Air Training Organisation Pvt. Ltd. at Salem became operational on 07.07.2023. Two FTOs namely Fly Ola Aviation Academy and Indian Flying Academy were inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation at Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh in July, 2023.

COMMISSION OF RAILWAY SAFETY (CRS)

- A. 14 statutory inspections of Network Expansion related work of Doubling / Multiple Lines / New Lines / Gauge Conversion for a length of 156.78 kms for Indian Railways and 5.94 kms for Metro Railways were done by the Commissioners and authorizations issued, thus making the cumulative total of these works during the year 2023-24 to 720.42 kms.
