3. The ICC shall serve as a single window system for attracting investments. The broad Terms of Reference of the ICC shall be as follows:

- To accelerate investments
- To bring projects to the Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS) that require special incentives, policy interventions, expeditious clearances and systemic reforms etc.
- To identify projects and report to EGoS
- To maintain active contact with investors and work with the States, duly adopting ways of onboarding the States to make them a part of the institutional set-up
- To identify policy and regulatory issue that come in the way of investments
- To engage with potential investors to bring the proposals for consideration of EGoS
- To address any other responsibility assigned by EGoS related to the above tasks.
