Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1. Ministry of Civil Aviation

- A. Passengers carried by domestic airlines during Jan-June, 2018 were **913.95 lakhs** as against **754.11 lakhs** during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a growth of **21.20%**.
- B. Bilateral talks were held between the delegations of Republic of India and Republic of Indonesia on 19th -20th September, 2018 at New Delhi. The provisions for domestic code share were incorporated in the ASA and 22 domestic points were agreed between the two countries.
