Vande Bharat Flights – A Quick Snapshot

- ✈ In view of COVID-19 pandemic, there was an urgent need for stranded and distressed Indians to travel back home.
- ✈ Several individuals of various nationalities stuck in India also needed to travel back to their respective countries.
- ✈ Air India was entrusted with the responsibility to fly to various countries for the purpose.
- ✈ From **7th May 2020** till date i.e. **13th July 2020**, Air India group (Air India and Air India Express) have operated **1103** flights and brought back **2,08,724** Indians.
 - ✈ **Air India :** **639 Flights carried 1,26,078 Indians**
 - ✈ **Air India Express :** **464 Flights carried 82,646 Indians**

Vande Bharat Flights – A Quick Snapshot

- ➔ It also helped repatriate **85,289** individuals of various nationalities on outbound flights from India.
 - ➔ **Air India** **78,037** passengers
 - ➔ **Air India Express** **7,252** passengers
- ➔ The whole operation has been carried out in four Phases (Phase-wise details of Evacuated Indians)

- ➔ Vande Bharat flights by Air India have covered **71** cities in **53** countries.
- ➔ Stranded Indians have been brought to **26** cities in **17** Indian States.

Vande Bharat Flights – A Quick Snapshot

- ✈ Earlier this year, Air India had successfully carried out evacuation from Wuhan and there after from Japan and Italy.
- ✈ This was first of its kind **medical evacuation exercise** in India and much different from the earlier exercises.
- ✈ By the sheer number of passengers and also by number of countries covered, it is **the biggest evacuation exercise by any civil airline in the world.**
- ✈ The biggest evacuation exercise before this evacuation, also by Air India, was in **1990-91** of stranded Indian from **Kuwait**, which had brought in **1,11,711** Indians on **488** flights.

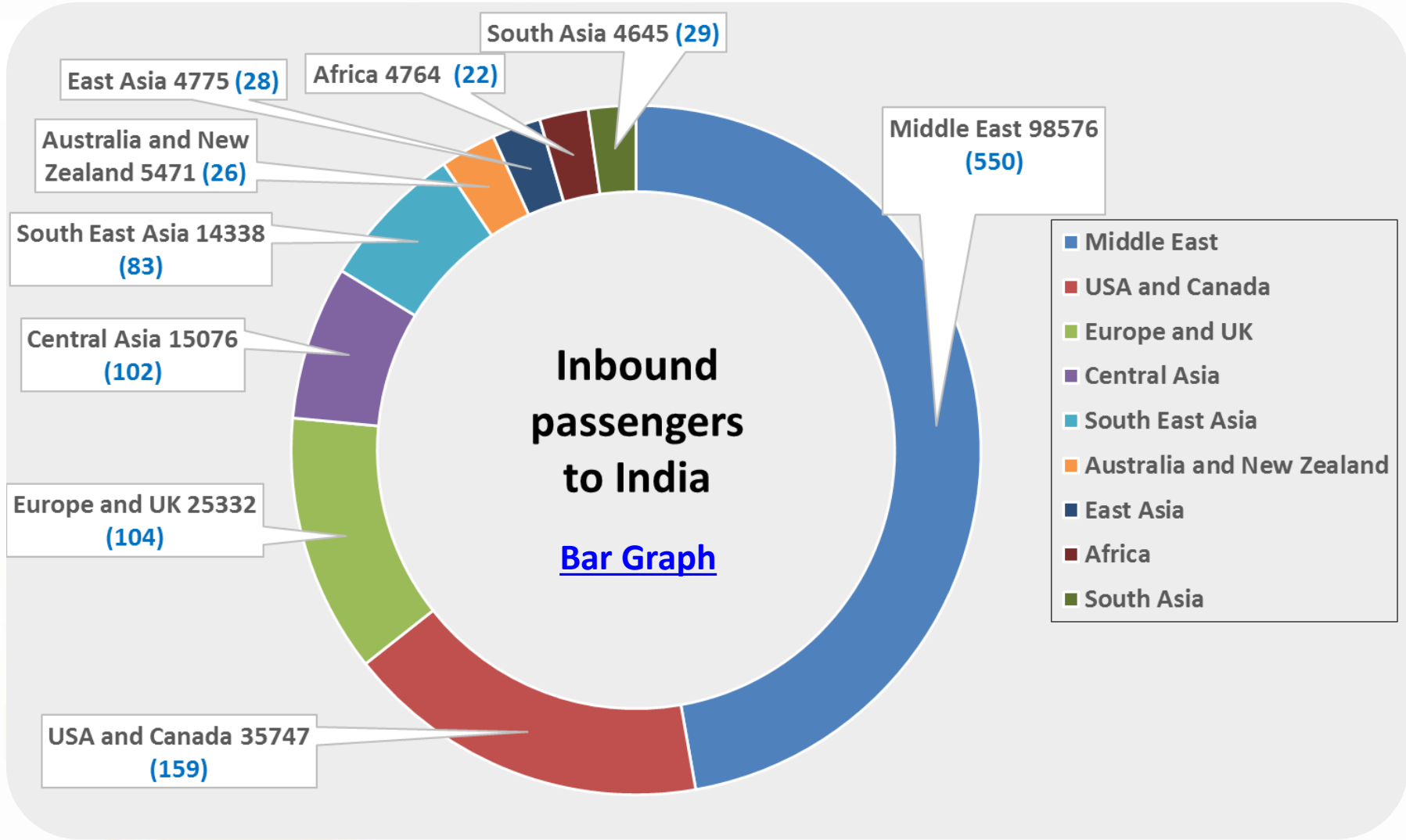

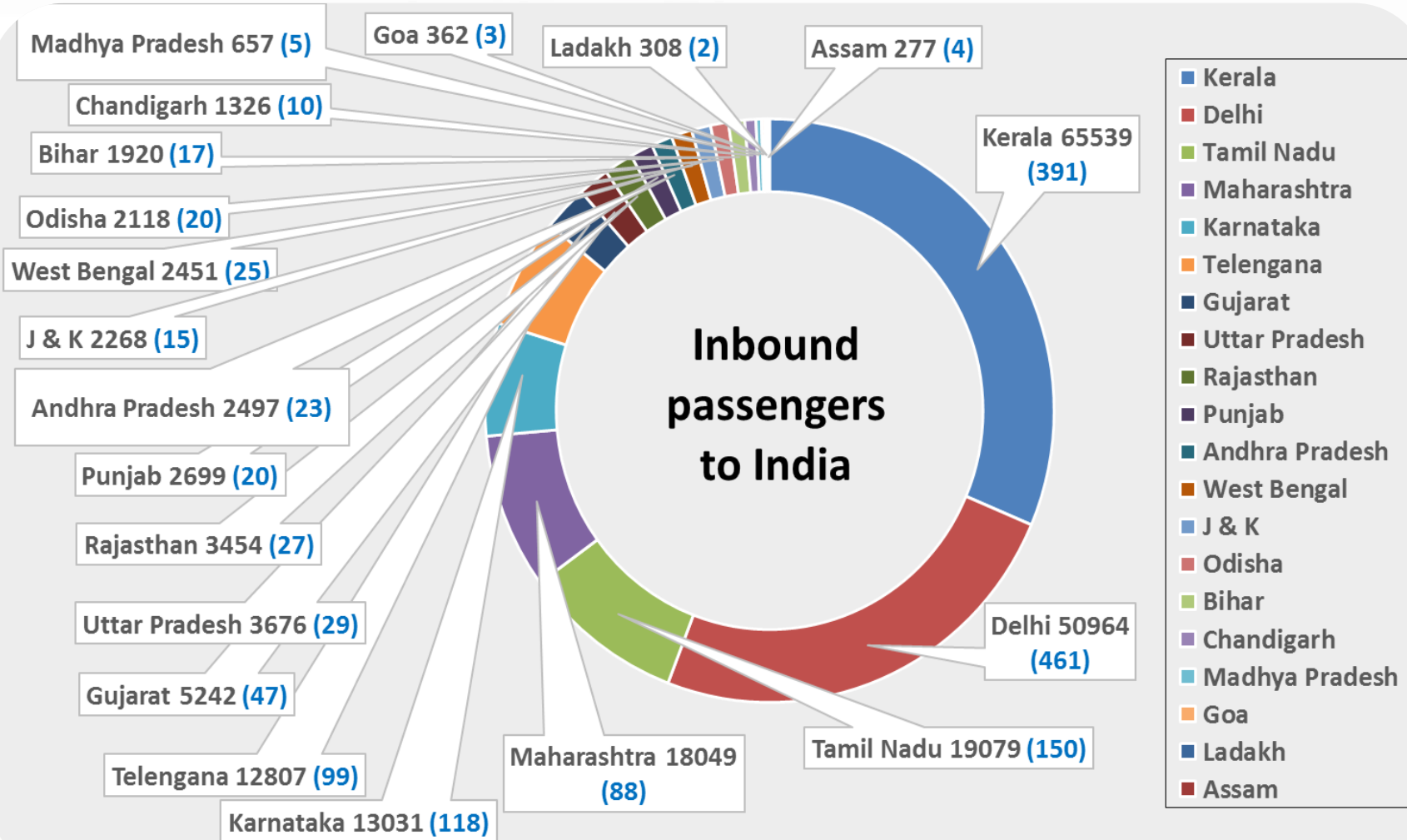
Inbound Passenger Flow by Geography



Figures in bracket shows the number of flights operated



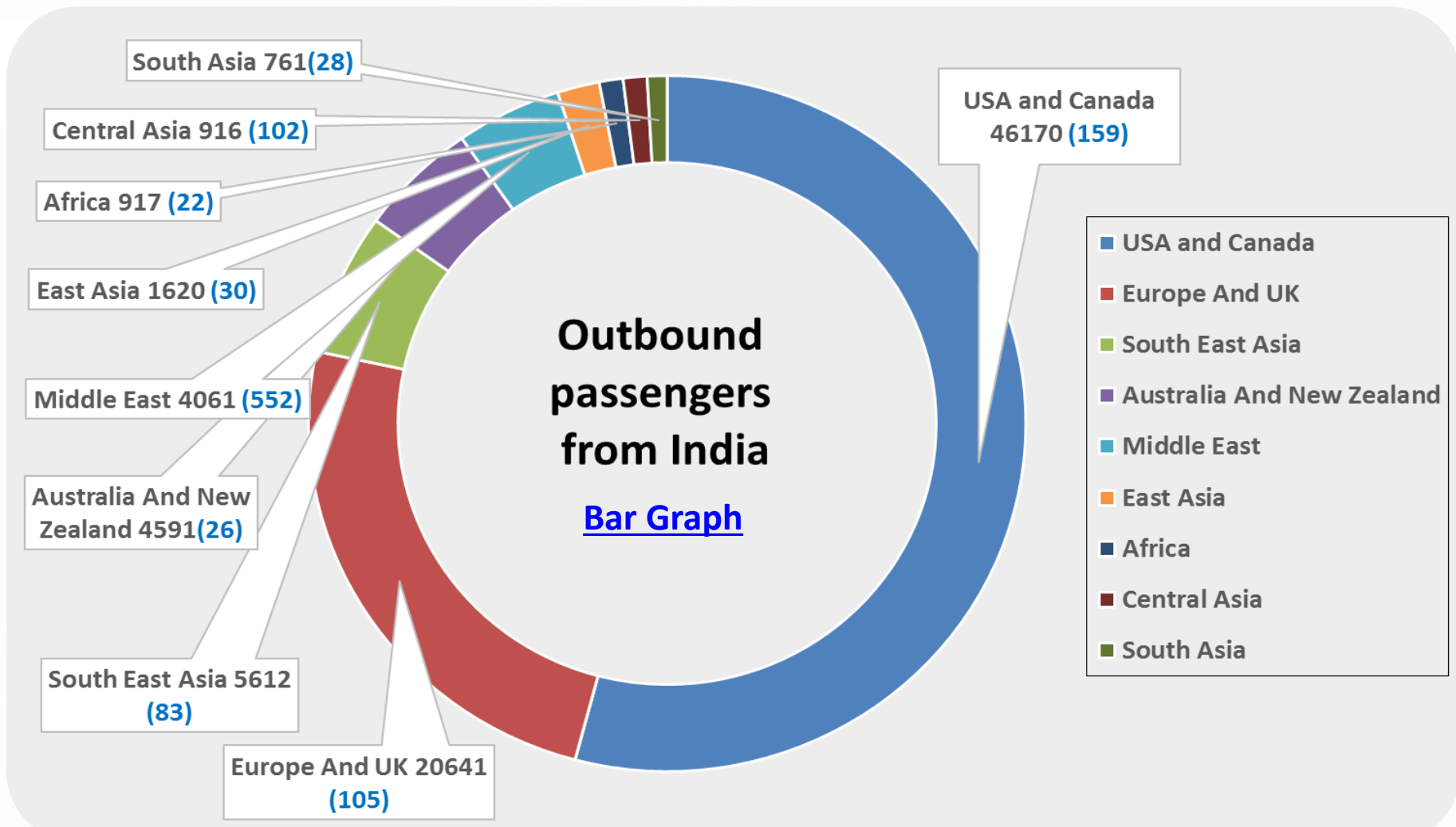
Inbound Flow to Indian States



Figures in bracket shows the number of flights operated



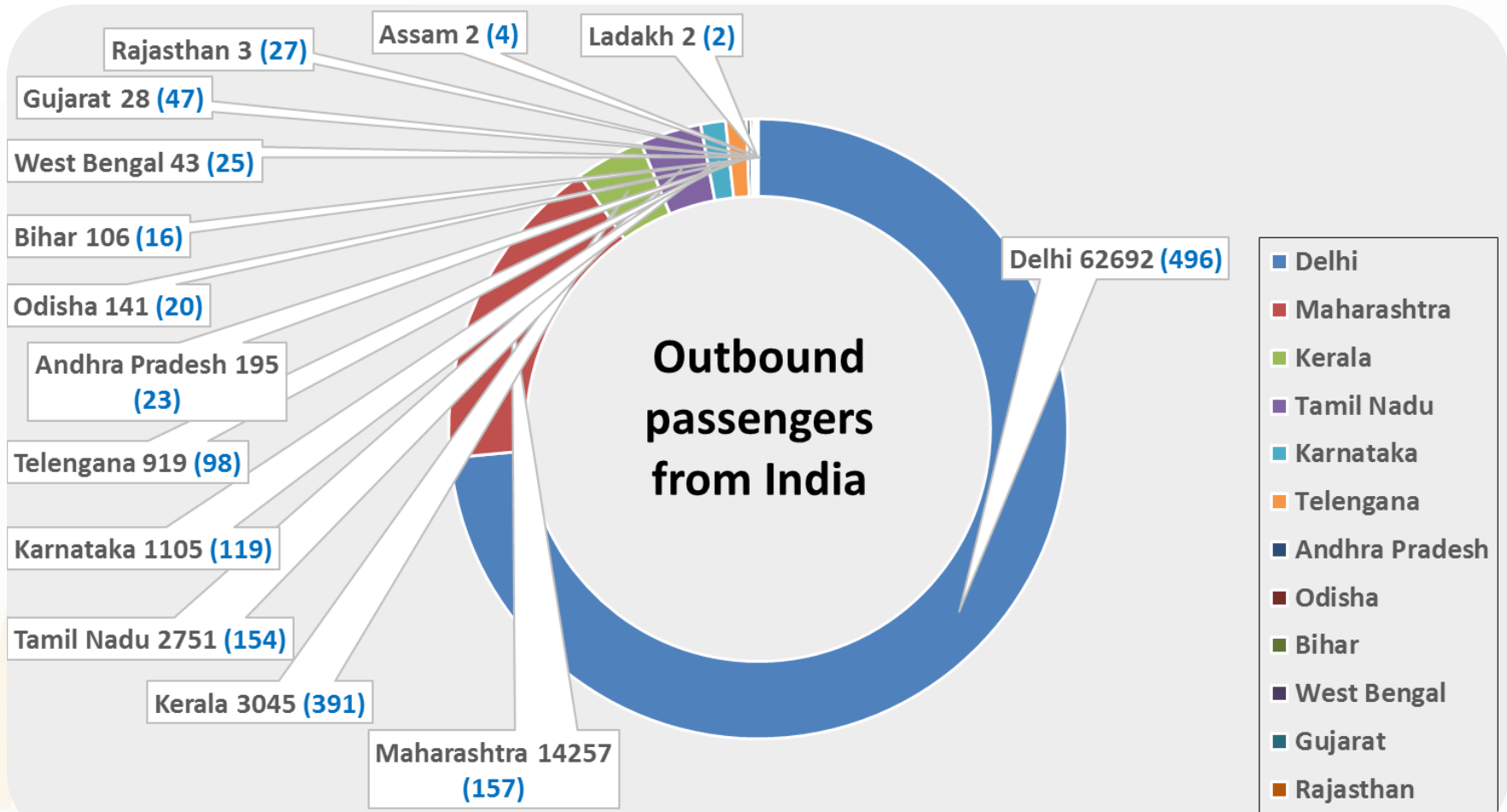
Outbound Passenger Flow by Geography



Figures in bracket shows the number of flights operated

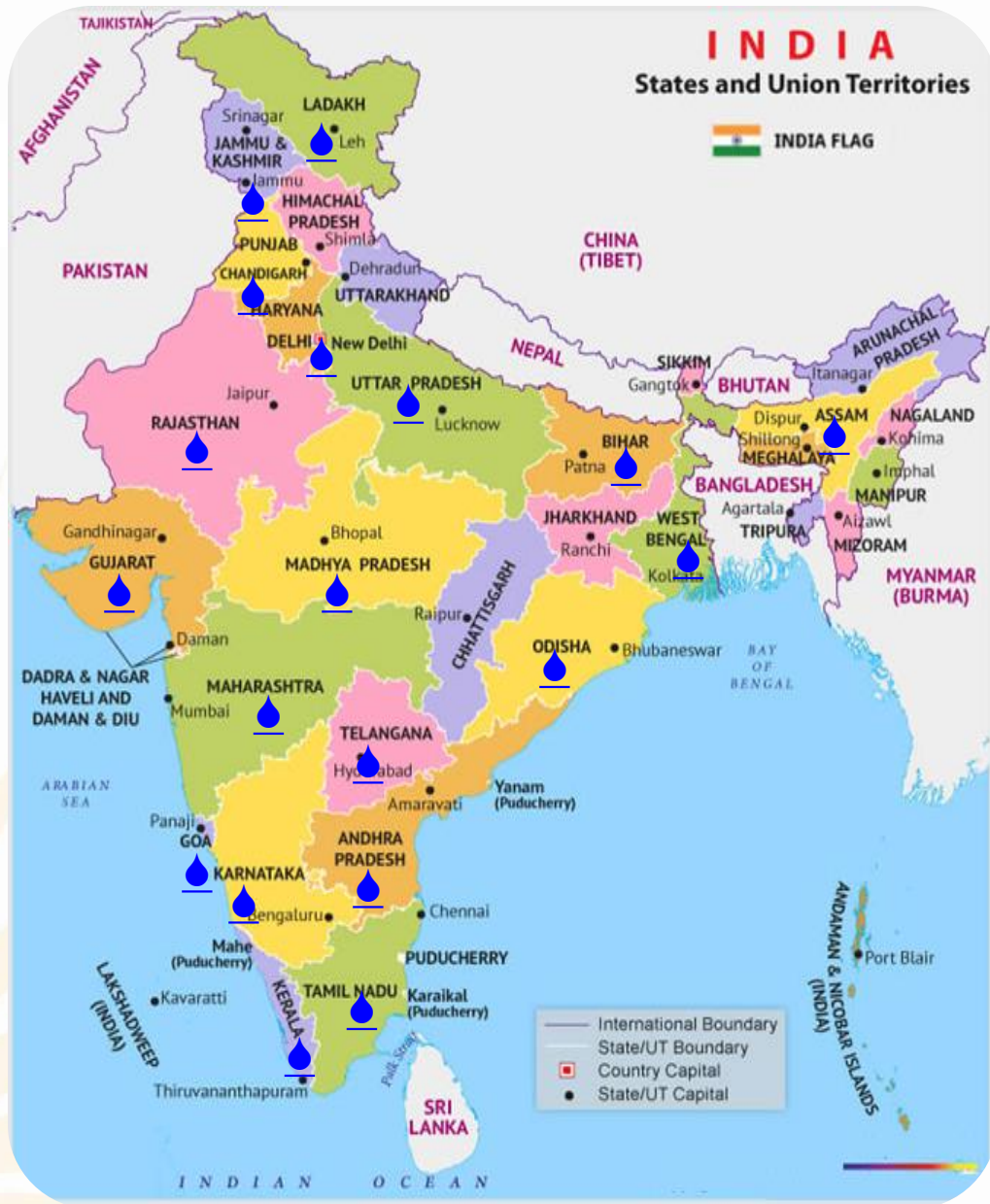


Outbound Flow From Indian States
